Birth of the Franciscans

Friar Bernard was the first to join Francis in ministry. Although from a noble family, Bernard was convicted by Francis's vow of poverty. He decided to follow in Francis's footsteps, leading a life dedicated to sharing the gospel and the contemplation of God.

Friar Leo was a cultured man, a priest, and a skilled calligrapher. He joined the Franciscan order and soon became the saint's confessor and secretary. From about 1220 up until the time of Francis's death, Leo was his constant companion.

St. Clare first heard the preaching of Francis when she was 18 years old. Against her family's wishes, she became a follower of the monk. Clare later founded the Order of Poor Ladies (commonly known as the Poor Clares), a religious order for women in the Franciscan tradition. Clare was the first woman to write a monastic rule of life.
